FOUNDER OF MODERN NURSING

Florence Nightingale

(12th May 1820 - 13th Aug 1910)

Florence Nightingale, born on 12th May, 1820, into a rich, upper class and well connected British family at Villa Columbia, near Porta Romana at Bellosguardo in Florence, Italy and was named after the city of her birth.



A year later she joined the Institute for Protestant Deaconesses at Kaiserswerth in Germany and from thereon she moved to a hospital in St. Germain, near Paris, run by the Sisters of Mercy.

An Anglican believed that God had called her to be a nurse; Florence announced her decision to enter Nursingin 1844.





She came to prominence for her pioneering work in Nursing during the Crimean War. On 4th Nov, 1854 Florence and 38 nurses entered the Barrack Hospital in Scutari and found the hospital to be filled with sufferings of the soldiers awaiting them.



In March 1854, Crimean War broke out. Russia invaded Turkey, Britain and France, concerned about growing power of Russia, went to Turkey's aid. The wounded soldiers, crowded into unsanitary ships, came from Crimean Peninsula on the other side of the Black Sea to the Barrack hospital in Scutari, Turkey.



Florence Nightingale was an innovator in the collection, tabulation, interpretation and graphical representation of descriptive statistics. For her contributions to army and hospital statistics, Florence Nightingale became the first woman to be elected as a Fellow of the Royal Statistical Society.

"What comfort it was to see her pass She would speak to one, and nod and smile to as many and more; but she could not do it to all you know We lay there by the hundreds, but we could kiss her shadow as it fell and lay our heads on the pillowagain content."

A soldier in the barnack hospital

Cecil Woodham Smith stated that "Two figures emerge from the Crimea as heroic, the soldier and the nurse. In each case a transformation in public estimation took place and in each case the transformation was due to Florence Nightingale."



Florence Nightingale is the founder of Modern Nursing. She was called "The Lady with the Lamp" As she would take night rounds in the ward which stretched 4 miles.

The first secular Nursing School established a Nursing School at StThomas, London in 1860.





Florence received many honours. She was invited to Windsor by Queen Victoria to receive The Royal Red Cross in 1833.

Student: Code of Conduct

- Every student of Career College and School of Nursing is expected to develop a sense of responsibility, self discipline, punctuality, sense of belongingness to the College, ensure active participation in the Curricular and Co-curricular activities, make optimum use of the learning resources offered by the College.
- 2. Every student is expected to give full respect in his/her action, deed and behaviour to the teaching faculties, non-teaching staff and the other authorities of the College. If any student is charged with misconduct/misbehaviour with other fellow students, girls, teaching or non-teaching staff., etc. the matter will be reported to the Disciplinary Committee and on its recommendations any warning, punishment, economic punishment, expulsion, suspension, rustication etc. will have to be acceptable to the student and his/her parents/guardian.
- 3. Every student is expected to develop the habit of reading various Notice Boards provided in the campus and be aware of all the information. For the convenience of students some information are uploaded on the college websites www.careernursing.org. Any information displayed on any Notice Board and/or websites will be deemed to have been brought to the notice of each and every student.
- 4. The entire college campus is declared as Ragging Free Zone. The college Management takes strict action against the students involved in Ragging. Every student is expected not to indulge in destructive activity such as Strike, Demonstration and Dharna etc.
- 5. In case of any complaint/grievance the student can approach the Grievance Redressal Cell. For the convenience of the students, Complaint cum Suggestion Boxes have been kept at various places in the college campus. The students may use these boxes to register their complaints/ suggestions. The decision of the Principal will be final and binding.
- 6. If a student wishes to remain absent continuously for more then 6 days, he/she has to make an application signed by his/her parents to head of the Department and take the prior approval, otherwise appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against him/her. The Examination form of the student will not be forwarded to the University in case if the total attendance of the student is below 100%. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance in theory and 100% attendance in each practical area.
- 7. The students are strictly advised not to use mobile in classroom, labs, office, corridors & clinical area. They should keep mobiles in switched off mode, not even on vibrator in the aforementioned areas. In case of breach of this condition the MOBILE PHONE will be confiscated by College staff which will be returned only after the student pays a fine of Rs. 500/- for the first time. If second time, the same student is found breaching this condition in the campus, his/her mobile phone will be confiscated and will not be returned in future.
- 8. The entry of the students in the College Campus is

- authorized only during the period of study/classes/Practical as per the schedule and with valid Identity Card and uniform. For all other time the entry of the students in the College Campus even with valid Identity Card and uniform will be considered unauthorized.
- The students are strictly prohibited from smoking, drinking alcohol, to spit in the campus or to get involved in any illegal/unethical practices including writing dirty things on the wall, board, etc. An appropriate action will be taken against the defaulters.
- 10. In case the student damages/destroys any college property in terms of Camera, Chalkboards/whiteboards, Switch Board, Fans (College Furniture). He/She will be imposed double the fine of repair/replacement of the damaged item and in extreme cases he/she may be expelled from the college.
- 11. The students are advised to use public transport to reach the college every day. However if the students bring their vehicle (two or four wheeler), they are expected to park their vehicle outside the Campus at their own risk. The College Management/ Staff /Security agency will not be liable for any kind of damage to the vehicle of loss/theft of vehicle whether parked in or outside the Campus.
- 12. Appearing in the internal assessment test is compulsory for every student. The student will be responsible for the consequence thereof if he/she remains absent himself/herself in internal assessment test.

UNIFORM/DRESS CODE:

All the students of Career College & School of Nursing are required to follow uniform as given below:

 $Boys/Girls: Sandalwood\,Shirt,\,Brown\,Trousers\,\&\,Black\,Shoes.$ In Winters: Black Sweater/Brown Blazer.

During Community posting:

Boys: They must wear Pink Shirt with collar, Brown Trousers & Black Shoes.

Girls: The uniform for girl students is Pink Salwar, Pink Dupatta with Pink Kurta and Black Shoes. White apron is required during Hospital posting.

Note:

- All the boys and girls of the colleges are strictly not allowed to wear the following:
 - (a) Jeans (Even of matching colour as per uniform)
 - (b) Tops (c) T-Shirts (d) Bermudas (e) Leggings
- All students are required to wear the prescribed college uniform in the college premises for any sort of official work (Leave application, TC, Bonafide, Fees structure etc.) also.
- Sunglasses, Lipstick or any other kind of make-up is strictly prohibited in the college premises.



छात्रों के लिए दिशा-निर्देश

- 1. कॅरियर कॉलेज और स्कूल ऑफ नर्सिंग में छात्रों से जिम्मेदारी की भावना, आत्म अनुशासन, समय की पाबन्दी, कॉलेज के लिए अपनेपन की भावना विकसित करने पाठ्यचर्या और सह-पाठ्यक्रम गतिविधियों में सिक्रय भागीदारी सुनिश्चित करने एवं कॉलेज द्वारा पेश किये गए शिक्षण संसाधनों का अधिकतम उपयोग करने की उम्मीद की जाती है।
- 2. प्रत्येक छात्र से यह अपेक्षा की जाती है कि वह महाविद्यालय के शिक्षण संकाय, गैर शिक्षण कर्मचारियों एवं अन्य अधिकारियों को अपने कार्य, व्यवहार में पूर्ण सम्मान दे। यदि किसी भी छात्र पर शिक्षण या गैर शिक्षण कर्मचारियों के साथ दुर्व्यहार का आरोप लगाया जाता है तो मामले को अनुशासनात्मक समिति को सूचित किया जाएगा और उसकी शिकायत पर किसी भी चेतावनी, सजा, आर्थिक दंड, निष्कासन की सिफारिश की जाएगी जो कि छात्र एवं अभिभावक को स्वीकार्य होगी।
- 3. प्रत्येक छात्र से यह अपेक्षा की जाती है कि वह कैम्पस में उपलब्ध कराए गये विभिन्न नोटिस बोर्ड को पढ़ने की आदत विकसित करे और महाविद्यालय के सभी सूचनाओं से अवगत हो, छात्रों के सुविधाओं के लिए कुछ जानकारी कॉलेज की वेबसाईट www.careernursing.org पर अपलोड की जाती है।
- 4. सम्पूर्ण कॉलेज परिसर को रैगिंग मुक्त क्षेत्र घोषित किया गया है। कॉलेज प्रबंधन विश्वविद्यालय/सरकार की दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुसार रैगिंग में शामिल छात्रों के खिलाफ सक्त कार्यवाही करता है। प्रत्येक छात्र से यह अपेक्षा की जाती है कि विद्धवंसक गतिविधियों जैसे धरना प्रदर्शन आदि में शामिल न हो।
- 5. किसी भी शिकायत के मामले में छात्र शिकायत निवारण सिमित से सम्पर्क कर सकता है। छात्रों के सुविधाओं के कॉलेज परिसर में विभिन्न स्थानों पर शिकायत सह सुझाव पेटी रखी गई है। छात्र अपनी शिकायत एवं सुझावों को दर्ज करने के लिए इन पेटीयो का उपयोग कर सकते है। प्रधानाचार्य का निर्णय अंतिम और स्वीकार्य होगा।
- 6. यदि छत्र 6 दिनों तक अनुपस्थित रहना चाहता है तो उसे विभागाध्यक्ष से अपने अभिभावक द्वारा हस्ताक्षरित आवेदन कर अनुमित प्राप्त करना अनिवार्य होगा। अन्यथा उसके खिलाफ अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाही की जाएगी। छात्रों की कुल उपिथित 100 प्रतिशत से कम होने की स्थित में छात्र का परीक्षा फार्म विश्वविद्यालय को नहीं भेजा जाएगा। छात्र की सैद्धांतिक में न्यूनतम 80 प्रतिशत एवं प्रायोगिक में 100 प्रतिशत उपिथित होना अनिवार्य है।
- 7. छात्रों को महाविद्यालय परिसर में मोबाइल का उपयोग वर्जित है। इसके बाद भी पहली बार मोबाइल पाये जाने पर कॉलेज के कर्मचारियों द्वारा चेतावनी देते हुए 500 रुपये का जुर्माना लिया जायेगा व दूसरी बार मोबाइल पाये जाने पर उसे जब्त

- कर लिया जाएगा।
- 8. कॉलेज परिसर में छात्रों का प्रवेश अध्ययन कक्षाओं के अविध के दौरान पहचान पत्र एवं कॉलेज यूनिफार्म के साथ मान्य होगा। अध्ययन अविध के अलावा कॉलेज परिसर में प्रवेश वर्जित है।
- 9. छात्रों का कॉलेज परिसर में किसी भी गैर कानूनी, अनैतिक कार्यों में शामिल होना प्रतिबंधित है। दोषी पाये जाने पर कॉलेज प्रबंधन द्वारा उचित कार्यवाही की जाएगी।
- 10.छात्राओं द्वारा कॉलेज की किसी भी सम्पत्ति को नुकसान पहुंचाने या क्षतिग्रस्त करने पर उक्त सम्पत्ति का दोगुना जुर्माना लिया जायेगा। अधिक नुकसान करने पर कॉलेज से निष्कासित कर दिया जायेगा।
- 11.छात्र को सलाह दी जाती है वह कॉलेज पहुंचने के लिए सार्वजनिक परिवहन का उपयोग करे। स्वयं के वाहन से कॉलेज आने पर वाहन का क्षतिग्रस्त होना, चोरी होना आदि के लिए स्वयं जिम्मेदार होंगे।
- 12.छात्र के लिए आंतरिक मूल्याकंन परीक्षा में उपस्थित होना अनिवार्य है यदि वह आंतरिक मूल्यांकन परीक्षा में अनुपस्थित रहता है तो उसके परिणाम के लिए छात्र जिम्मेदार होगा।
